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What is the program about?

TEACHER USA, is a cultural and professional exchange program that allows Mexican teachers to teach in accredited elementary and secondary schools in the United States for **a period of 1 to 5 years with a J1 VISA.**

Through this program, educators have the opportunity to develop their careers internationally while sharing the rich cultural heritage of Mexico with U.S. students.



Application requirements

Teachers must:

- Meet the qualifications for teaching in primary or secondary schools in their country of nationality or last legal residence;
- Be working as a teacher in the home country or country of legal residence at the time of application, or, if not working as a teacher, otherwise meet the eligibility qualifications and **(a)** have recently (*within 12 months of application*) completed an advanced degree and **(b)** have two years of full-time teaching experience within the past eight years;
- Have a degree-equivalent to a U.S. bachelor's degree in either education or the academic subject field in which they intend to teach;





Teachers must:

- Have a minimum of two years (*24 months*) of teaching or related professional experience;
- Satisfy the standards of the U.S. state in which they will teach;
- Be of good reputation and character;
- Be seeking to enter the United States for the purpose of full-time teaching as a teacher of record at a primary (*including pre-kindergarten*) or secondary accredited educational institution in the United States (*pre-kindergarten teachers must teach full-time, and at the pre-kindergarten level, may teach only language immersion at an accredited host school*);
- Possess sufficient proficiency in the English language.

Application requirements

Program benefits

- **International teaching experience** in accredited schools.
- Possibility of **bringing your spouse and children** with a J2 visa.
- Professional development and cultural growth.
- Health insurance for 90 days and repatriation coverage.
- **Assistance with the visa process** and arrival in the USA.
- Opportunity to improve your English and **enhance your professional curriculum.**





Placement options

You can choose between two types of placements in the **TEACHER USA** program:

placement

- We find them a school placement according to their experience.
- They do not get a choice on where they are placed
- They can turn down jobs, but we will limit this.

independent

- Able to choose location, school, etc

Fees and expenses

- **550 USD Application fee:**
It is paid at the time of applying to the program in order to obtain a contract.
- **2,500 USD Acceptance fee (*Placement*):**
You can split this payment into 3 installments scheduled for January 15, February 15, and March 15.
- **1,500 USD Acceptance fee (*Independent*):**
You can split this payment into 3 installments scheduled for January 15, February 15, and March 15.
- **1,100 USD Program Renewal fee:**
Annual fee due in June of each program year

Compensation

By working as a teacher at a school in the United States, you receive financial compensation in U.S. dollars.

For one year of work.

This salary depends on the contract signed with the workplace and the number of hours worked.

NOTE: By law, the U.S. government will withhold a percentage of taxes from the salary (an average of 10%), which may vary depending on the state and the participant's age.

Additional fees

The program fee **DOES NOT INCLUDE:**

- Visa cost **(\$185 USD)**, paid directly to the U.S. Embassy.
(The price is determined by the embassy and may change without prior notice.)
- SEVIS cost **(\$220 USD)**
**SEVIS Extension Fee - \$367 (Fee paid directly to the U.S. Department of State and subject to change)*
- Foreign Credential Evaluation Fee **(\$200 - \$400 USD)**
(exact amount depends on number of transcripts being evaluated)
- Annual State Teacher Certification **(\$100 - \$250 USD)**
- Teacher Certification Renewal Exam **(\$100 - \$200 USD)**
- Criminal Background Check **(\$40 - \$200 USD)**
(Exact fee depends on school, state and background check agency)
- TOEFL Test
- J-2 Dependent Application Fee **(\$550 - \$650 USD)**
(Only if applicable)
- Medical Insurance Upgrade **(\$1.10 USD/per day)**
- Passport cost
- Airfare cost
- **Accommodation and food expenses**
